Rules and Conditions

1. Exhibitors must be current financial members of the Donkey Society of Victoria or of another affiliate of the Affiliated Donkey Societies of Australia.
2. Entries may be posted or emailed and must be received by 25 March 2019. Late entries will not be accepted.
3. Entries must be accompanied by full fees. Entry fees may be paid by Direct Deposit to: Donkey Society of Victoria Inc. Bendigo Bank, BSB 633 000, Account Number 110009818 (please provide your name as a reference), or by cheque or money order (made out to Donkey Society of Victoria Inc.) posted to: Pat Streefkerk, 725 Dickins Road, Freshwater Creek, Vic 3217.
4. Jack Handlers must be 18 years of age or over.
5. Jacks 2 years and older must wear a headstall fitted with a chain or a bridle fitted with a suitable bit and chain.
6. Donkeys and Hybrids in all ridden classes must be 3 years of age and over.
7. Helmets which comply with AS/NZS 3838 Current Australian Standard, New Australian Standard ARB HS 2012, Current British Standard PAS 015, or Current US Standard SNELL E2001 are compulsory in all ridden and harness events.
8. Excessive use of whips and spurs in any class will not be tolerated.
9. Any donkey/hybrid found to be unfit will be excluded from exhibiting. The Judges' decision on this matter will be final.
10. Only equines entered in events are permitted to attend, unless prior approval has been received from the organisers.
11. The Judge may combine or divide classes at their discretion.
12. The Judge(s) has the authority to withhold awards when exhibits are in their opinion unworthy of a prize. The judge(s) may award a second or third prize in place of a first or withhold a prize altogether when the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.
13. Donkeys/hybrids age to be taken by Date of Birth. If not known, 1st August of the estimated birth year to be used.

14. Any protest must be in writing and lodged with the Chief Steward within 30 minutes of the class/event being judged. A cash deposit of \$20 must accompany the written protest and will be forfeited if the protest is proven frivolous. The Show sub-committee decision is final.
15. During judging, the only person permitted in the ring with the donkey/hybrid shall be the rider, driver, handler, and groom. An official photographer may be present without hindering the activities.
16. In the obstacle classes competitors are expected to walk the course prior to the commencement of the class. No donkey or hybrid will be permitted on the course prior to competing.
17. Competitors are expected to provide their own yards or tethering facilities.
18. All exhibitors must bring their own bags for the collection of manure. Owners are responsible for removal of manure from the grounds, or to a suitable designated area.
19. Dogs must be on a lead and kept under control at all times. A dog owner who does not abide by this rule may be asked to leave the grounds. Entry money will not be refunded.
20. The Championship Show sub-committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any person on the day of the Show, or to remove any animal that may be, or reasonably be expected to be, diseased or dangerous.

Champion and Reserve Champion Performance Hybrid

Performance championships are awarded to the highest points accumulated for classes 22 – 36.

Points 1st = 4, 2nd = 3, 3rd = 2, 4th = 1

In the case of equal aggregate points, the Champion and Reserve Champion will be determined on a count back basis, starting with first places.
